Dear Parents/Guardian:

Maschio's Food Services is pleased once again to be offering lunch daily at each school in the Tewksbury School District. Lunch may be paid for in cash at the checkout line or money/check may be sent in on a daily, weekly or monthly basis. Each student has an account to which money can be applied and will be identified by entering their PIN number at the checkout so their meal can be accounted for. Your student will keep the 'same' PIN number from kindergarten through 8th grade.

Checks should be made payable to "T.T.B.O.E." and <u>include the student's full name written</u> <u>clearly on the check.</u> Unless you let us know otherwise, your student may use the monies in his/her account to buy any items we sell. We've attached the September menu for your viewing as well as an itemized price list for discussing the items/prices with your child(ran). Also attached is the Payment Form on which you may place requests for <u>Lunch Only</u> or <u>No Snacks</u>.

Any student enrolled in Tewksbury schools, grades K-7 last year who had a balance in their account at the end of the school year will be able to use that money this year EVEN IF they changed schools. A student may have a maximum lunch account balance of negative three-dollars and ten cents (-\$3.10). After this negative balance has been reached, if no monies are received, the student will receive a hardboiled egg, a package of crackers and a milk for lunch until a deposit is made to their account. You can check your child's account balance any time by logging on to Realtime.

Also, as a reminder, at the end of each school year, monies left in your 8th grader's account can be credited to another sibling's account
